Governor Cooper Announces 500 Jobs as Global **Battery Component Supplier Selects Brunswick** County for First U.S. Plant

Indian manufacturer Epsilon Advanced Materials will invest nearly \$650 million

Epsilon Advanced Materials, Inc., a global provider of synthetic graphite used in electric vehicle batteries, will build its first manufacturing facility in the United States in Brunswick County, creating 500 jobs, Governor Roy Cooper announced on October 26, 2023. The Indian-based company will invest \$649.9 million at the Mid-Atlantic Rail Industrial Park.

West Burnsville Industrial Park Improvements Move Forward

The 47-acre industrial park was formally certified by the NC Department of Commerce as a North Carolina Certified Site on October 26, 2022, and is being marketed as North Carolina's newest certified industrial site in western North Carolina. In December 2022, the Rural Infrastructure Authority awarded a \$600,000 grant from the North Carolina Industrial Development Fund - Utility Account. The grant from the Utility Account will support a roadway extension and will be invested alongside additional infrastructure grant dollars toward development of the site, with design, permitting, and development of the park scheduled to begin in 2023. The county owned site offers water, wastewater, natural gas, electric, and broadband internet all available on site.
